
Baroque Motif Dreidel



Directions

Fold along the inside lines, making a top shape.
Glue so all the flaps are inside the top.
Stick a straw or wooden dowel through the tiny circle at the top (push it gently to the bottom of the dreidel). Add glitter or other embellishments.

Now you can play dreidel or use as place markers or treat holders, etc.

To play - Each player starts with about 20 markers (like chocolate coins, checkers, nuts, or raisins) and takes turn spinning the dreidel. On each spin, the players put 2 markers in the center. Do the following for each spin:


(from bottom to top of the pictured letters)
nun - do nothing
gimel - take everything
hay - take half
shin - put one in

The winner is the person who gets all the markers.

Note: Nun, gimel, hay, and shin are the Hebrew letters used on the dreidel outside Israel (they represent the phrase, "A great miracle happened there.") In Israel, the letters represent the phrase, "A miracle happened here."
